## BIODATA

### A. Remzi SEZGİN Merkez Yönetim Kurulu Başkanı



11 Eylül 1943'te Afyonkarahisar'ın Çay ilçesinde dünyaya geldi. İlköğretimini Çay Kurtuluş İlkokulu'nda, ortaöğretimini Ankara'da tamamladı. Yüksek öğrenimini 1965 yılında Ankara Teknik Yüksek Öğretmen Okulu'ndan birincilikle mezun olarak tamamlayan Sezgin, bir taraftan Kocaeli Bayındırlık Müdürlüğü'nde ve Kesikköprü barajı inşaatında teknik eleman olarak çalıştı. Yükseköğrenimini tamamladığı yıl hizmete açılan Bolvadin Yapı Meslek Lisesi'nde Millî Eğitim Bakanlığı'nca öğretmen ve Okul Müdürü olarak görevlendirildi. 1967 yılında 'Avrupa Konseyi Bursu'nu kazanarak "Yapı Malzemeleri" alanında lisansüstü eğitim görmek üzere gittiği Hollanda'da Delft Teknik Üniversitesi ve Rotterdam Bouwcentrum'da öğrenim gördü. Yurda dönüşünde Manisa Salihli Endüstri Meslek Lisesi Müdürlüğü'ne atandı. Salihli'de bu görevinin yanı sıra Akşam Ticaret Lisesi Müdürlüğü'nü de vekâleten yürüttüğü yıllar boyunca ilçede anaokulu, halk kütüphanesi, Akşam Ticaret Lisesi gibi önemli tesislerin açılmasını sağladı. 1974 yılında Erkek Teknik Öğretim Genel Müdürlüğü Şube Müdürü olarak atanan Sezgin, 1978 yılında Genel Müdür Yardımcılığı görevini üstlendi. 1980 yılında atandığı Meslekî ve Teknik Öğretim Yapı İşleri Daire Başkanlığı görevini yürüttüğü esnada kurulan İnşaat Emlak Genel Müdürlüğü'nde Genel Müdür olarak görev aldı. Daha sonra ismi Yatırımlar ve Tesisler Daire Başkanlığı olarak değiştirilen ve 1990 yılına kadar sürdürdüğü bu görevinin ardından, önce Yükseköğretim, Yurtdışı Eğitimi ve Dış İlişkiler Genel Müdürü olarak, daha sonra da Bonn (Almanya) Büyükelçiliği'ne Eğitim Müşaviri olarak atandı.

Yurda dönüşünde Araştırma Planlama Koordinasyon Kurulu (APK) Başkanı olarak atanan Sezgin, 1999 Yılında Müsteşar Yardımcılığı görevine getirildi ve bu görevinden 2008 yılında emekli oldu. Bütün bu görevleri esnasında Japonya, Almanya, Fransa, Belçika, İngiltere, İspanya, Tayland, Portekiz, Meksika, İrlanda başta olmak üzere birçok ülkede özellikle eğitim yapıları ve tesisleri ile ilgili birçok konferans, sempozyum ve seminere katılan Sezgin, ülkemizde de Millî Eğitim Bakanlığı'nca merkez ve taşra teşkilatındaki yöneticilerin eğitimlerine yönelik düzenlenen hizmetiçi eğitim programlarında öğretim üyesi olarak görev yaptı. Görevi süresince binlerce eğitim tesisinin yapımını sağlayarak hizmete sunulmasında emeği bulunan, bir dönem OECD (Uluslararası Kalkınma ve Ekonomik İşbirliği Örgütü) Eğitim Yapıları Programı Yönetim Kurulu Üyeliği görevini yürüten Sezgin, Kore Seul Olimpik Parkı Türk Çeşmesi, Bangladeş Atatürk Lisesi'nin yapımı, Milli Eğitim Bakanlığı Başöğretmen Anıtı yapımı projelerini gerçekleştirdi. İngilizce, Almanca ve Hollandaca bilen Sezgin, halen Millî Eğitim Vakfı Yönetim Kurulu Üyesi ve Başkan olarak eğitime hizmetlerini sürdürmektedir.

## Professor Ralph Tabberer CB

Ralph has 40 years' experience in schools, research, teacher training and policy. He was Director General of Schools in England between 2006 and 2009, after serving for six years as Chief Executive of the Teacher Training Agency.

Unusually for someone who has worked at the heart of government, he has a strong background in teaching and learning research and he brings insights from cognitive science into all his work. Since 2009, he has worked as much abroad as in the UK on a rich mixture of projects including the building of premium international schools and the formation of ground-breaking social projects carrying education to the poorest rural communities in southern India.

Ralph left the UK civil service in 2009 and moved to the Middle East to join the international private school operator, GEMS as Chief Operating Officer and Chief of Schools. In 2012, after a highly successful period steering GEMS through the recession and preparing it for growth, Ralph established the first of his own businesses, supporting schools. He now owns, co-owns and chairs five educational businesses providing consultancy, solutions, management, HR and recruitment support for nurseries and schools, and for international school chains.

Ralph is renowned as an education leader who is steeped in classroom practice. As a former teacher and researcher into how children study and learn, he has expertise in curriculum, pedagogy, student assessment, teacher development, enterprise education and the new technologies. At GEMS he supervised schools running the American, UK, Indian, Arab and IB systems.

Ralph is a graduate of Cambridge University and a qualified teacher. In the New Years Honours list of 2009, Her Majesty The Queen invested Ralph as a Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath (CB) in recognition of his services to teacher training and to schools. He is a visiting professor at the Institute of Education, University College of London and an Honorary Professor at Warwick University. As a former regulator of one of the world's largest national systems, he is often in demand not only as a business leader but also as a governmental adviser. He 'brokered' the entry of North London Collegiate School into the Middle East and Singapore and, among his projects, is currently helping Riverston School start up a special education branch in Dubai.

He has recently completed work on 'Affordable Schools' in Ghana, India, Kenya, the Philippines and South Africa.

Kathryn Joy has more than 20 years of experience in Primary Education. After graduating from Cambridge University with a first class degree in Education, she worked in a number of primary schools in the United Kingdom. During this time she developed her leadership skills and gained a Master's Degree (MA) in Primary Education.

Kathryn is passionate about working with students and teachers to make them the best that they can be and has developed this passion by working as an Educational Consultant and Adviser over the past ten years. Recent work has included teacher training for high profile International schools in South East Asia. In her role as Teaching and Lead for Cambridge University Press, Education, Kathryn is delighted to be offering training and support to schools, teachers and students in Turkey and beyond through the International Primary Teaching Programme.
